



An 18th Century Saint

His Spiritual Counsel, "Don't Do What You Want and Then You May Do What You Like," Changed His Disciple's Life.

Sri Sadasivendra Saraswati Swami, familiarly known as Sadasiva Brahman, was one of those rare souls who occasionally grace this earth and remind erring humanity that the ideal of perfection laid down in the Hindu *shastras* (scriptures) is not a mere abstraction but is possible of actual realization even in this age of Kali (Dark Age).

He was born in the beginning of the 18th century and had his education at Tiruvisanallur in the Tanjore District. We have lost even the names of the parents of this saint and this is no matter for surprise, as his greatness was realized only after he became a *sannyasi* (renunciate) and free from all worldly connections. That he was a very deep scholar is clear from his works, *Brahma-Sutra-Vritti*, *Yoga-Sutra-Vritti* and *Siddhanta-Kalpavalli*. We may easily deduce from this fact itself that he came from a

line of erudite scholars and had his education from an equally learned teacher.

After the close of his educational career, he returned home and his parents found for him a noble and handsome bride; but somehow his leanings were ever toward the path of renunciation. When his betrothed reached marriageable age, she left her parents' home to go to her husband. To commemorate this happy event a feast was arranged and a large number of guests were invited. Naturally there was delay in serving dinner that day and our young boy asked his mother the reason for it. She said with a face beaming with joy, "Your wife will be coming home shortly."

He reflected that, if the prospective coming home of his wife was enough to upset his daily program of studies, the actual coming home must be a veritable disaster which

he must avoid at any cost. He quietly left the house without the knowledge of anybody and was not heard of for some time, when he was found as a *sannyasi* disciple at the feet of Sri Paramasivendra Saraswati Swami, the learned commentator of *Uttara Gita* and author of *Dabaravidya-Prakasika*.

He not only became an adept in the Vedanta dialectics of those times but became a practical Yogi also. His youth and his keen intellectual grasp sometimes led him into discussion with the learned scholars who came to visit his Guru. He seems to have taken special pleasure in worsting them in argument, so much so that on one occasion the Guru himself was vexed and exclaimed, "When will you learn to control your tongue?"

Vow of Silence

Sadasiva replied, "Even now, my lord, if I have your grace." From that moment he gave up all talk and began to observe complete silence. He found that this *mauna* (religious silence) was of great help to him in the practice of Yoga.

Within a very short time he became a Yogi of a very advanced type. He forgot the world and, intoxicated with the glory of Self-realization, unconcernedly walked through the streets, danced through forests, slept on the sands, ate when he got anything, starved when he did not and, some thought, was no better than a madman. This news was carried to his Guru Paramasivendra and the latter in

great joy exclaimed, "Oh! If only others had such madness!"

At times he would test himself and see whether the world had ceased to affect him. Heat and cold did not affect him, censure and praise did not touch him, pain and sorrow were no more for him, hunger and thirst had ceased to be for him, doubt and darkness had disappeared altogether; he was all Light, all Joy.

Sometimes as a witness he would watch the roamings of his physical frame, the wanderings of his mind and the workings of his intellect as if they were things quite external to himself.

Once when he was seated in *samadhi* (state of divine communion) on the sands of the Kaveri near Kodumudi in the Coimbatore District, suddenly a flood came. To the consternation of the villagers on the far-off shores, he was carried away. Some weeks later when the sands had dried and a number of people came to cart away some sand, one of them found his spade meet with some obstruction. He was horrified to find it stained with blood. Immediately they dug out the spot and it was with mixed feelings of pain and pleasure that they recognized the form of our saint deeply imbedded in the sands. He woke from his *samadhi* and walked away from the group as if nothing had happened.

Strange Meeting

His physical body, stark naked as it was, marched one day straight into a tent where a Mohammedan

chief was resting with his ladies in private. The Mohammedan got wild at this seeming impertinence, drew his sword and cut off the Yogi's right arm. His body, feeling some impediment, turned right about and marched away unconcerned. The Mohammedan who saw this was astonished beyond all bounds and recognized the sage.

He immediately picked up the fallen arm and ran after him to implore his forgiveness. But the sage was quite oblivious to the world: it was impossible to wake him up from his state of *samadhi*. After some time he recognized that there was a man before him weeping and muttering something, and wanted to know what the matter was. The Mohammedan recounted his guilt, showed the fallen arm and pointed to the bleeding stump and implored mercy. The saint quietly took the fallen arm, stuck it up in the stump of his arm and began to walk away.

The Mohammedan felt that he would be missing the greatest opportunity of his life if he did not profit by this strange acquaintance with this great sage. He fell before him and implored him to give him some words of advice which he could treasure and follow to the end of his life.

Wonderful Words

The sage, struck with his earnestness, wrote on the street dust: "Don't do what you want and then you may do what you like," and passed on.

The new disciple imbibed this strange advice. He wanted to re-

turn to his tent. But the advice did not permit him to do so. He wanted to walk at least to ease his limbs, but he could not because of this advice. His legs were aching and he wanted to sit but could not. He felt hungry and wanted to eat but could not. He felt thirsty and wanted to drink but could not. He felt tired and wanted to sleep but he could not do even this, for fear of disobeying the advice. He wanted to live at least on the pleasures of the past, but he dared not recall them to mind, nor could he dwell on any hopes for the future. In short, he found that his body and his mind must cease to be active in any respect.

When reduced to such a state of helplessness, he suddenly realized that by restraining the activities of the body and the mind, he himself really became free, free from the limitations imposed by them, and blissful beyond all expression. He became one with the elect and in a short time reached the further stage where he could do what he liked. Caste and creed had ceased to be for him, religion and society had nothing to teach him. He had become one with the One Life pulsating through the entire universe. Such is the effect of contact with the great, and of earnest faith in their words.

Sri Sadasivendra was not only a perfect *Jnani* (sage) but was a great Yogi also. He naturally despised the *siddhis* (miraculous powers) which usually attend on Yogis; but there were occasions where they showed themselves even

without reference to him and at other times he himself played with them to astonish the ordinary people and infuse faith in them.

Miraculous Events

One night the Yogi was walking aimlessly in his own absent-minded way. A grain-store in the middle of a threshing-floor obstructed his passage and his body spread out its limbs and leaned on in and remained in that posture. Some servants of the owner, who came during the night to see if everything was safe, thought that they had found a thief red-handed and lifted their sticks to strike him. But lo! their raised arms refused to come down or to release the sticks. Like statues they were unable to move a single inch and they remained like this till dawn, when the owner himself came to the field.

He could not understand the stiff posture of his servants or their vacant stare till he saw the reclining form of the saint on the grain. Before he could approach the saint, the latter walked away in his usual unconcerned manner and the servants recovered the normal use of their limbs. It is well-known that such results are not due to any conscious volition of the saints but are due to the nature of the actions themselves.

On another occasion when the servants of an official did not find sufficient men to carry some heavy loads of fuel, they requisitioned our saint without knowing who he was. They placed a load on his head and

drove him along with the others to the camp of the official. When all the others had unburdened themselves of their loads, our saint also was asked to do so. He immediately threw his load on the heap of fuel and lo! the entire heap caught fire and blazed away to the painful astonishment of all.

On one occasion the children, with whom he was ever a great favorite, desired to see the image of God Sri Minaksi-Sundara going in a grand procession during a festival at Madura, about one hundred and fifty miles from where they were. He asked them one and all to get up on his body and close their eyes for a second. When they did so and opened their eyes, they found themselves witnessing the procession and in the midst of a vast crowd.

Ideal Travel

The sage bought them some festival sweets and after some time brought them back home in the same manner. The parents were astonished to hear the glowing descriptions of the festival given by the children and more so to see the remnants of the several sweets given them by the saint from the festival shops.

Evidently after hearing this incident a young man requested the sage to take him to Srirangan for a festival just then going on. He was also asked to close his eyes and was in a moment taken to Srirangan; but unfortunately his saintly guide was missing when he wanted to return and the young man had

to walk home all the distance! When he reached home, he was surprised to learn that the sage did not leave the place at all during the day.


One day the sage said suddenly that on a certain approaching date, he would be leaving his physical frame, and that a *linga* (religious object) which would be brought from Benares just then should be consecrated at the place. Everything happened as foretold by him and it is that *linga* that is now an object of worship at Nerur at an annual festival.

Vijaya Raghunatha Thondaman, ruler of the Pudukota State from 1730 to 1769, had a very great respect for this sage, so much so that he treasured, and his successors still treasure, as sacred even the sands on which the Yogi wrote some religious instructions for the guidance of that prince. A large number of endowments have been made by that state in favor of the temple erected to the sage at Nerur in the Trichinopoly District.

It is the occasional appearance of such great souls that keeps aloft the torch of spiritual enlightenment ever blazing in the land of the ancient *rishis* (sages). It is a matter for great congratulation that the darkest days of India have not been without her saints and that it is not possible to deplete her of her spiritual wealth.—*Kalyana-Kalpataru*.



Spiritual Interpretation:

"As the soulful people one by one were expressing their wisdom thoughts, one deeply penetrating soul perceived that all men consciously or unconsciously were seeking to behold truth through the all-seeing astral eye of wisdom hidden in the forehead. When other souls heard this they remarked to one another: "Behold through the eye of wisdom, that God has bound all souls together with the strings of all-pulsating, all-pervading

Cosmic Life which is resonant with the creative sound of cosmic vibration."


All life is activity. Wherever there is activity there is vibratory sound. Hence, when God throws His cosmic motor of creation into activity, it vibrates and emanates a cosmic sound. The wise, by calmness and meditation can hear this cosmic rumble behind all other sounds.

Applied to Daily Life:

No matter how many theological arguments men hear, they all can find truth when they behold it through the hidden eye of wisdom. All those who open their spiritual eyes knowingly look at one another and say: "Ah, God holds together the beads of all lives with the string of cosmic life and cosmic vibration."

Glossary:

- 1—*The Vessels*—The vehicles of wise souls.
- 2 *One spied*—One deep soul saw with wisdom.
- 3—*The little Crescent*—The spiritual eye of astral light and wisdom.
- 4—*All were seeking*—Everyone consciously or unconsciously is trying to develop the spiritual eye or the orb of all-knowing wisdom.
- 5—*Hark*—Listen with deep attention.
- 6—*The Porter*—The Divine Conveyor who carries all human vessels, strung and inter-knotted with universal life.
- 7—*A-creaking*—Vibrating with the cosmic sound, responsible for universal creation and the burden of human lives.



SOUL FORCE

By Mahatma Gandhi



(Mahatma Gandhi, writing in his paper, *Harijan*, makes the following explanation of *Satyagraha* (Soul Force or Non-Violence), in reply to a correspondent who writes: "Why can't you see that while there is possession it must be defended against all odds? Therefore your insistence that violence should be eschewed in all circumstances is utterly unworkable and absurd. I think non-violence is possible only for select individuals.")

"I claim that even now, though the social structure is not based on a conscious acceptance of non-violence, all the world over mankind lives and men retain their possessions on the sufferance of one another. If they had not done so, only the fewest and the most ferocious would have survived. But such is not the case. Families are bound together by ties of love; so are groups in the so-called civilized society called nations. Only they do not recognize the supremacy of the law of non-violence. It follows, therefore, that they have not investigated its vast possibilities.

"Hitherto out of sheer inertia,

shall I say, we have taken it for granted that complete non-violence is possible only for the few who take the vow of non-possession and the allied abstinences. Whilst it is true that the votaries alone can carry on research work and declare from time to time the new possibilities of the great eternal law governing man, nevertheless, if it is the law, it must hold good for all. The many failures we see are not of the law but of the followers, many of whom do not even know that they are under that law willynilly. When a mother dies for her child she unknowingly obeys the law.

"I have been pleading for the past fifty years for a conscious acceptance of the law and its zealous practice even in the face of failures. Fifty years' work has shown marvelous results and strengthened my faith. I do claim that by constant practice we shall come to a state of things when lawful possession will command universal and voluntary respect. No doubt such possession will not be tainted. It will not be an insolent demonstration of the inequalities that surround us every where. Nor need the problem of unjust and unlawful possessions appal the votary of non-violence. He has at his disposal the non-violent weapon of *satyagraha* (soul force) and non-cooperation which hitherto has been found to be a complete substitute of violence whenever it has been applied honestly in sufficient measure.

"I have never claimed to present the complete science of non-violence. It does not lend itself to


such treatment. So far as I know no single physical science does, not even the very precise science of mathematics. I am but a seeker, and I have fellow seekers like the questioner whom I invite to accompany me in the very difficult but equally fascinating search."


Music,



Spiritual Interpretation OF THE ★ BHAGAVAD GITA

*Why All Emancipated Sages Stressed the Need for
Service and Action.*

By PARAMHANSA YOGANANDA

Chapter III, Stanza 1

Literal Translation:

O Janardana, if Thou dost consider understanding as superior to actions, O Keshava, why then dost Thou employ me in this awful activity?

Poetic Rendition:

O Janardana, if Thy mind deems knowledge more precious and priceless to pursue than automatic activities, then why, O Lord, dost Thou want me to be harnessed to the stallions of boisterous, fearful actions?

Spiritual Interpretation:

The above stanza of *Bhagavad Gita* depicts the mental conflict of a

devotee who contacts God through fitful intuition and often wonders why the inner wisdom coming from Him considers knowledge as superior to activities, at the same time It urges the devotee to perform tremendous mind-engaging activities.

Every devotee must know that ultimate wisdom is the ocean of Bliss without the changeable waves of passing sorrow or momentary pleasure or any form of actions which belong to the world of temporal vibrations. Hence the unchangeable substance of Spirit is superior to its manifesting waves of changes, even as the ocean is greater than the waves. The ocean is superior to the waves for it is the cause of the existence of the waves

and because the ocean being the prime cause can exist without the waves, whereas the waves cannot exist without the ocean.

Salvation in Action

So the sea of Spirit is the supreme cause and is superior to the waves of all vibratory creation. The spirit is changeless, self-sufficient wisdom, and all vibratory activities coming out of it are conditioned and hence inferior. So in every man is found the presence of the all-supreme wisdom in his deepest interior soul, and the vibrating activities in his exterior body. Hence, though it is true bodily activities are inferior to soul wisdom, still no wisdom can be achieved without some sort of bodily activities. In other words, the vibrationless state of all-supreme wisdom cannot be attained by man in the beginning, as he is born in delusive activities first. So he has to take out from the foot of his being the thorn of painful active delusion by another thorn—good action. Thus when the thorn of mundane activity is extracted from the being by the thorn of good activity, then the soul throws away both thorns and becomes anchored in the one spiritual wisdom transcending all activities.

Therefore, all spiritual devotees must heed this warning of *Bhagavad Gita* that though knowledge is superior to activity still ultimate knowledge can not be attained without philanthropic, social, religious and meditative activities. When one is sure of having attained the finality, he is then not bound to

act in any definite set of human actions.

To set a good example to their followers, all great emancipated masters like Jesus, Babaji, Lahiri Mahasaya, my Guru, even though it was not necessary for their own good, engaged themselves with some spiritual activities calculated to do good to others. Various social, moral, religious, spiritual, meditative activities are the different rungs and steps in the ladder of salvation which every devotee must first climb in order to reach to the top roof of ultimate, all-satisfying all-complete, all-supreme wisdom.

The Eastern love of wisdom must be combined with the western love of activity in order to attain joy. Hence both the East and the West are one-sided and should constructively exchange their experiences in order to reach the common goal of highest wisdom.

Deeper Spiritual Interpretation:

The sacral, lumbar, dorsal, cervical and medullary plexuses should be centers of conscious spiritual activities. The devotee, by process of oxygenation, proper breathing methods and various deep meditative activities, should also constantly centralize his consciousness in the spinal centers. Then he will be eligible to remain in the non-vibrationless, non-active state in the thousand-rayed lotus light of Spirit in the cranium.

Some devotees, after temporarily attaining the vision of the centralized manifested light of Spirit in the brain, often give up spiritual

breathing exercises, considering them as an inferior meditation. This is a mistake. All spiritual activities, special meditations and proper breathing exercises must be performed and continuously followed in order to have the vision of the thousand-rayed spiritual lotus light in the brain, and to be permanently anchored there.

Every devotee should remember that though it is the supreme state to remain locked up in the spirit light in the brain, still meditative activities must come first. Meditative activities produce wisdom in the mortal man, though meditative activities are inferior to wisdom after it is attained.

Hence all devotees should first be busy throughout life in meditative activities in order to attain the all-supreme final wisdom. No devotee while meditating deeply should abandon meditative and religious activities.

"Janardana" signifies the ideal Guru who can show the devotee the way to destroy misery-making rebirths. "Keshava" signifies the ultimate state of Spirit, beyond the creative, destructive, void states of vibration.



We must school ourselves in riddance to the point of having no personal belongings. We may realize it or not, but attacks of restlessness are due solely to the personal will. We ought then to commit ourselves and all our thoughts, will-and desire-free, to the good-will of God therewith unreservedly to desire and will.—*Eckhart*.

Beware, therefore, that you lean not too readily upon some preconceived desire without having sought God's counsel; lest, perhaps, afterwards you repent of it, and begin to regret the course you have adopted, which at first pleased you, and for which you were zealous, as it seemed the best.

SUN., Sept. 20. Sometimes indeed you must use violence, and manfully fight against sensual desires, not regarding what the flesh likes or does not like; but making it rather your business to bring the unwilling flesh into subjection to the Spirit.



Second Coming of Christ

Steps Toward the Attaining of the Consciousness
Which was in Christ Jesus

*Can a Spiritual Guru Lighten the Load of
his Disciples' Bad Karma?*

He spake also this parable; A certain man had a fig tree planted in his vineyard; and he came and sought fruit thereon, and found none. Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground?

And he answering said unto him, Lord, let it alone this year also, till I shall dig about it, and dung it. And if it bear fruit, well: and if not, then after that thou shalt cut it down.—Luke 13: 6-9.

In the above words, Jesus speaks of the power of a Guru-Preceptor who can intercede and help a misguided disciple from suffering the results of evil actions. The "vineyard" refers to the good disciples, the "fig tree" represents the sinner and the "dresser" represents the spiritual leader who "prunes" or disciplines his followers. The following true story illustrates how a real guru-preceptor who is in tune with God can intercede for a lagging disciple.

Swami Pranavananda, a great disciple of Lahiri Mahasaya (master of my master), told me this story: "I and another friend of mine had been meditating eight hours every night for eight years. We used to sleep in the daytime and meditate all night, when silence and quietness reigned everywhere in the city of Benares. In the course of eight years' deep meditation, I had had visions of saints and great peace came upon me, but it seems, due to some past karma of my past lives, there was a barrier between me and the final vision of God.

My Difficult Search

"Whenever I told my Guru-Preceptor, 'Master, I meditate practically all night but do not seem to succeed,' he repeatedly consoled me by saying, 'Meditate deeply; you have lots of past karma to overcome.' But after eight years of ever-increasingly deepening meditation on my part, during which I left no stone unturned in trying to contact God, I began to get mentally discouraged and inwardly felt tired.

"One night I made up my mind that as my Guru-Preceptor was consciously in touch with God, he could intercede on my behalf and ask God to forgive my past actions and manifest Himself to me. Armed with this determination, I went to Lahiri Mahasaya and said, 'Sir, tonight I have come to quarrel with you. I have done everything that you have told me and yet I have not made the final grade

of actually meeting Brahma (God)." Lahiri Mahasaya tried to stave me off by consoling arguments, that sometime soon I would have His contact. But I paid no attention, and went on calling and demanding, as a son would with his mother, to gain some favor. After two hours of arguments and quarreling, at last Lahiri Mahasaya, convinced of my determination, suddenly said, 'Don't bother me any more. Your wish will be fulfilled tonight.'

"I went back to my home. As I was meditating deeply that same night, it happened. Brahma, the Cosmic Vision of the Infinite, manifested within me that night. As flowers fall when the fruit comes, so from that day I had not to meditate any more, for I had gained the object of meditation—the contact of Spirit, which has remained the same ever since that day, and will ever remain the same throughout eternity."

It must be remembered that the Swami who told me this story did not attain final emancipation just by eight years of meditation. He had meditated several lives before. But his final contact with the Infinite was obstructed due to some past evil actions. His Guru-Preceptor, Lahiri Mahasaya, interceded for this disciple and helped him to make the final grade.

Good Past Lives

All those that have started meditation in the path of God in this life have surely meditated on God in many of their past lives. Mil-

lions of people live in the world who, because of their past materialistic lives, never think of meditation now. Their unwillingness prevents them from seeking God. Their unwillingness is born of materialistic living of many lives.

Every one who has a great tendency in this life to know God ought to be very much encouraged to meditate more and more with deepest concentration, for if he does so, he will surely contact God.

No devotee just because of meditation can summon God to manifest within him. Every devotee must forsake metaphysical egotism which consists in thinking, "I have meditated so much and God must manifest Himself." With deep meditation there must be deep devotion and surrender to God. Surely then God becomes entrapped in the net of the devotee's unconditional devotion.

In the above story is illustrated the parable of Jesus, how a disciple with evil karma can find, by the help of a real guru-preceptor, ultimate emancipation.

And he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the sabbath. And, behold there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself. And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity. And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

And the ruler of the synagogue answered with indignation, because that Jesus had healed on the sabbath day, and said unto the people, There are six days in which men ought to work: in them therefore come and be healed, and not on the sabbath day. The Lord then answered him, and said, Thou hypocrite, doth not each one of you on the sabbath loose his ox or his ass from the stall, and lead him away to watering? And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the sabbath day? And when he had said these things, all his adversaries were ashamed: and all the people rejoiced for all the glorious things that were done by him.—Luke 13: 10-17.

"Woman, through divine grace, your past karma is burnt up and you will be free from your infirmity." Jesus healed the woman by laying his hands over her. By this method, Jesus sent the positive healing cosmic energy through his right hand and the healing negative cosmic energy through his left hand. The cosmic energy entered the body of the woman and made the life force bring about the required repair in the body.

Life Force Has Power

The life force in the body has the absolute power to construct or destroy the body. But the life force can only perform according to the will of the bodily owner. Most people don't know that their will

can command the body to perform miraculous changes in it. When this human will becomes paralyzed or doesn't know its power over the life force in the body, the life force remains disobedient most of the time to the action of the will. When this will is paralyzed by disease, it must be stimulated by the strong will of a mighty healer. Then the paralyzed will of the patient becomes healed and, being stimulated by the healer's will, the life force in the patient's body becomes awakened to perform the desired healing in the patient.

And he went through the cities and villages, teaching, and journeying toward Jerusalem. Then said one unto him, Lord, are there a few that be saved? And he said unto them, Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able.

When once the master of the house is risen up, and hath shut to the door, and ye begin to stand without, and to knock at the door, saying, Lord, Lord, open unto us; and he shall answer and say unto you, I know you not whence ye are:

Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets. But he shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence ye are; depart from me, all ye workers of iniquity. There shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth, when ye shall see Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, and all the prophets, in the kingdom of God, and you yourselves

thrust out. And they shall come from the east, and from the west, and from the north, and from the south, and shall sit down in the kingdom of God. And, behold, there are last which shall be first, and there are first which shall be last.—Luke 13: 22-30.

In response to the question, "Lord, are there few that be saved?" Jesus replied in the following way, "All those who strive to enter into the kingdom of cosmic consciousness, through the help of a guru-preceptor and the best technique taught by him, will find the straight gate of Self-realization to enter into the Infinite, for there would be many, I say unto you, who will try to seek the kingdom of God and enter in there by themselves, after ignoring the God-given Guru-Preceptor, like myself, sent to them. But they won't succeed because they ignore the divine messenger, the God-sent Guru-Preceptor.

Lost Opportunity

"When once the Master Guru-Preceptor is taken away from the earth, he has to shut the door of his teaching. Then if anybody comes and knocks at the door of prayer and says, "Lord Guru-Preceptor, open the divine door to me," then the Guru-Preceptor will reply, "You had the opportunity to receive me and you did not, and hence I cannot accept you." Then if those people again say, "Lord Guru-Preceptor, we ate and drank in your presence, you have taught

in our streets, and why shouldn't you respond to our prayers?" the inner voice of the praying devotee will say, "The Lord doesn't know you, you must depart, for you are a worker of iniquity."

All souls who want salvation must recognize the Guru messenger of God sent to them in response to their prayers. If they don't they won't find salvation by themselves in that life or in the astral world after death. But when they are reborn again, if they pray for a Guru and continue to meditate, God will send them a Guru messenger again for their redemption. Every devotee who ignores the divine messenger sent in response to his prayers has to undergo the punishment of not meeting another Guru-Preceptor in that earthly life and in the astral world after death.

"I prophesy that in future many devotees shall arise in the eastern part of the world, in the western part of the world, in the northern part of the world, and in the southern part of the world, and by their devotion they will meet right Guru-Preceptors and learn to meditate properly and place their consciousness in the cosmic consciousness of God the Father and behold, there will be many devotees among them, devotees from different parts of the world who will meditate to the last days of their lives and they shall be the first to enter into the kingdom of cosmic consciousness. But there will be many devotees among them who though they started meditating early in their

lives, still they were not regular in their meditation, and that is why after a long time in the end if they persist they will at last attain cosmic consciousness."

Must Follow Guru

In the above words, Jesus speaks of the paramount necessity of following a guru when he is once sent in response to the devotee's prayer. No one can even casually meet a Guru-Preceptor without possessing good karma. Therefore those devotees who ignore the Guru-Preceptor and then repent and desire to know God after the Guru is gone, may develop by persistency of meditation so much that after their death they may be close to heaven. Such a devotee has thus made some progress.

But that is all he can get; he will see many other prophets and devotees who followed their Guru present in heaven, but he won't be able to get in there. He will have to come back on earth to repent again and pray and meet the God-given Guru-Preceptor and find salvation through him.

Usually God Himself does not teach but He uses the speech, mind and consciousness of an advanced Guru-Preceptor to teach the seeking devotee. When God once sends a Guru-Preceptor in response to the disciple's innate craving, he must obey the Guru or he will not find salvation at least in one life or in the astral world after death. When once a disciple adopts a God-sent divine messenger or Guru, he cannot be changed in any incar-

nation. A true Guru and a true disciple form the divine pact that they will help each other through love, understanding, loyalty and meditation, until final emancipation in God is reached. It must be remembered that all those devotees who ignored a great Guru can have, after death, a glimpse of heaven, if they earn it through spiritual merit.

Jesus meant that those seekers who ignored Him in his earth life and yet persistently sought the kingdom of God and His contact, after Jesus was gone from the earth, after death, would be granted a glimpse of heaven where they would see Isaac, Jacob and all prophets lodged in the kingdom of cosmic consciousness. Only they won't be allowed to get in at that time.

However, it must be remembered, something is better than nothing, that all those devotees who have a glimpse of heaven would surely form within their souls a great desire to get into the kingdom of God. Such souls, when they are reborn, from their birth have extraordinary desires to know God. Such desire for God, when fed by prayer and good action and spiritual seeking, would attract unto them through God the right Guru-Preceptor who would show them the path of God.

In the above words, Jesus makes it very plain who can enter into the kingdom of God. He never said only a few or many could enter into the kingdom of God, but he said that those who are true seekers after truth attract unto them the

right Guru-Preceptor. If they follow that God-sent messenger, that would be the easiest door or straight gate to enter into cosmic consciousness. Therefore, it is evident that all seekers after the kingdom of God should pray deeply and seek until they find the right Guru-Preceptor who has God-contact and is sent in response to that devotee's prayers.

Hope of Heaven

Jesus in the above words also gives hope of heaven to all the prodigal children of God, in all of whom is hidden the potential image of God. In response to the question "Can only a few enter the kingdom of God?" Jesus does not limit the number or make heaven the monopoly of a few spiritual aristocrats. Instead, Jesus emphasizes that many God-seeking devotees — Christian, Hindu, Moslem, Jewish, and many kinds of devotees — will arise in the four corners of the earth. Only those will be really qualified by persisting in the divine path from the first time they started in it to the end, until salvation is reached. They will be the first or, comparatively quickly, will enter into the cosmic consciousness and the state of final emancipation. But all those devotees who start in the path of God but are irregular in following the divine path may take several incarnations (provided they are persistent) to attain cosmic consciousness and attain final emancipation.

That is what Jesus meant by the last shall be the first and many who

are first shall be last. All the devotees whose spiritual enthusiasm after entering the spiritual path is uniform and persistent to the end will be the first to attain cosmic consciousness. But those devotees who first enter the spiritual path and then become slow or irregular in traveling that path of meditation, might take more than one incarnation to at last enter cosmic consciousness and attain final emancipation.

It is wonderful to know that Jesus assures all truth-seekers that they will surely find God because they are made in His image, provided they give up their prodigal roaming in the land of ignorance and material consciousness. Through the help of a proper Guru-Preceptor one can retrace his footsteps by regular meditation back to the home of cosmic consciousness.

Salvation Delayed

Jesus tells us that only truth seekers who ignore the divine messenger sent in response to their prayers will find their salvation delayed. But all humans, even the greatest sinners, whenever they would understand the folly of their evil actions, will repent. All those who repent of their wickedness and strenuously try to follow the spiritual path will certainly meet the right Guru-Preceptor and reach the cosmic state of consciousness. In a competitive examination, many who come first to enter into it may be the last to pass, and many who are last to register may stand first in the examination, through earnest application.

According to Jesus, it isn't the time when a devotee enters the spiritual path that counts, but his persistency in the spiritual path, as the real cause for attaining the kingdom of God. Jesus distinctly says that devotees from east, west, north, south, by persistent seeking and the help of an exemplary soul or Guru-Preceptor, will finally be able to sit down or permanently place their consciousness in the kingdom of God or cosmic consciousness.

The same day there came certain of the Pharisees, saying unto him, Get thee out, and depart hence: for Herod will kill thee. And he said unto them, Go ye, and tell that fox, Behold, I cast out devils, and I do cures today and tomorrow, and the third day I shall be perfected. Nevertheless I must walk today, and tomorrow, and the day following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish out of Jerusalem.

O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; how often would I have gathered thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, and ye would not! Behold, your house is left unto you desolate: and verily I say unto you, Ye shall not see me, until the time come when ye shall say, Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord.—Luke 13: 31-35.

“Go and tell that wicked Herod that I have come to cast out ignorance and devils during a certain

period of time of my life as ordained by the Heavenly Father and after that, but not before, I will be crucified. Then I will reach final perfection through the help of the Father, after three days of curing or working out my past karmas in the astral world. Now, however, in spite of the wicked Herod and all his powers, I will walk free today, tomorrow, the following day and so on until my time comes, for events cannot be otherwise than as the prophets foretold, of my body perishing in Jerusalem.

Like a Divine Mother

"O Jerusalem, O, people of Jerusalem, who kill the prophets and who stone those who are sent by God, how often I have gathered you all under my divine protection as a hen would protect her brood under her wings, but you did not like to be saved from the ravages of delusion. Remember, all of you will find your life's houses empty and desolate, unable to feel me as the Christ Consciousness in everything. Of truth I declare unto you, you will not see my body nor the Christ Consciousness in it until the time comes when you shall repent and meditate and expand your consciousness so that the Christ Consciousness, manifest in me for a first time, may manifest in you for a second time.

"When you realize and are able to manifest the Christ Consciousness in your consciousness, then in vision you may see me as Jesus, not before."

In the above words, Jesus dis-

tinctly shows his all-knowing nature. When people told him that Herod would kill him, Jesus replied that nothing could happen to him until the divinely ordained and karma-ordained time had arrived for his crucifixion and perfection on the third day.

When Jesus says, "On the third day I shall be perfected", it is distinctly evident that Jesus was both human and divine, and that by prayer and use of divine will he had to reach perfection.

All souls are potentially divine but as soon as they enter the flesh they suffer imperfection. It takes time for those souls to regain their perfection as they rise above the body's attachment through incarnations, and go back by meditation to Spirit. Those that are intensely desirous of going back to God can accomplish perfection in one life, provided they meditate deeply and can attain ecstasy (*samadhi*). If Jesus was completely divine he would not have said, "On the third day, I shall be perfected."

Jesus knew that he had to do the work of casting out ignorance from others, spreading wisdom, communing with God, and working out all his karma of the physical, astral and causal bodies, in the three days after crucifixion. Then his soul would attain complete unity with the Father.

Unity with God

Whenever Jesus said, "I and my Father are one", he meant he felt potentially and through his advanced wisdom his unity with God.

But he says here that he would irrevocably attain the consciousness of complete unity with the Father, after he had worked out all his karma in his earthly life and in the three days after crucifixion.

Jesus regretted that, although the people of Jerusalem had such a great opportunity to be saved, they did not care to listen to wisdom, and persecuted the prophets.

So Jesus said, "Jerusalem and people of the world who do not appreciate me, someday you will seek me and the Christ Consciousness in me, but you will not be able to find that, until you have repented of your material ways and attained spiritual development. The omnipresent Christ Consciousness which appeared in my body will remain unmanifested until devotees expand their consciousness and tune in with Christ Consciousness. The Christ Consciousness, first manifest in me in this age, must manifest a second time in the meditation-expanded consciousness of the devotee. Then and then only will the devotee be able to feel the Christ Consciousness as it is manifest in me, as well as have a vision of my body in which Christ Consciousness has been manifested."

SCIENTIFIC DIGEST

MIND EXPERIMENT

Fresh evidence that the mind is the ruling source of both cause and effect has just been made of record by the *Journal* of the American Medical Association, which reports that a group of selected football players raised their endurance 200 per cent in three weeks, just by taking sugary tablets which they believed contained gelatin, but which didn't, and which had nothing that could possibly have any physical effect on them.

Other players were given sugary tablets which did contain the chemical, aminocetic acid, which, one school of thought maintained, does increase endurance. This group also improved 200 per cent, but they did not outdo the sugar tablet boys. The experiment was conducted under the direction of the Federal Food and Drug Administration.

The football players were led to believe that all the tablets contained gelatin. This was purposely done to determine what effect, if any, could be attributed to suggestion alone, under carefully controlled conditions.

All in the Mind

The work was pedaling bicycles. Each group pedaled 13 days without tablets and showed no appreciable improvement. Then tablets were given and after two or three weeks both groups went up

200 per cent. Then, still without the players knowing it, the tablets were switched, so that the gelatin boys got only sugar, and vice versa. The result was still the same.

"It is interesting to note," said the report, "that the work capacity of all subjects invariably increased when they received tablets with the suggestion that they would counteract fatigue."—*Chapin Hall*, in *The Los Angeles Times*.

THE STABLE EARTH

Dr. Edward Teller, professor of physics at George Washington University, assured the Columbia University Chapter of Sigma Xi that the sun on which our earth depends for maintenance of the status quo has not varied enough to melt any rocks on the earth in the last 2,000,000,000 years, and that in the last 500,000,000 years it has not varied beyond the limits which permit the orderly development of its life.

Dr. Hans Bethe, professor of physics at Cornell University, before the Brooklyn Institute of Arts and Sciences recently looked into the future in connection with the atomic-energy sources of heat in the sun. He predicted that this parent body of the solar system will remain in almost exactly its present state for about 10,000,000,000 years.

He added, with a mischievous glint in his eye, that he thought that probably would be sufficient for the nations of the earth to effect a settlement of their difficulties and settle down for a period of peace. If we have not achieved permanent peace in this 10,000,000,000-year period of stability which nature promises us it will not make much difference, because then, it is predicted, the sun will flare up like a dying ember and settle down to its next phase of existence as a white dwarf.—*John O'Neill in The New York Times.*

HEAVY ATOMS SHOW MECHANISM OF LIFE

Fundamental new knowledge of the mechanism by which the body keeps "the wick of life" burning at a steady flame, provided by a new "atomic searchlight" fashioned of five types of "tagged" atoms, was presented recently at a meeting of the American Chemical Society by Dr. David Rittenberg of the Columbia University School of Medicine.

Dr. Rittenberg received the \$1,000 Ely Lilly award in biological chemistry at the opening of the convention for his researches in which the twins, or isotopes, of hydrogen, carbon, nitrogen, oxygen and sulphur were introduced into the food of animals for tracing their course through the living body, making it possible for the first time to watch "the master chemist" at work.

The study was begun several years ago at Columbia by Profes-

sor Rudolf Schoenheimer, after Professor Harold C. Urey, Columbia Nobel Prize winner in chemistry, discovered the existence of a new type of hydrogen, with an atomic weight twice that of ordinary hydrogen.

Digestive Process Is Studied

Since hydrogen is one of the most important constituents of food as well as of the living body, Dr. Urey's discovery, followed by the concentration of the heavy hydrogen, made it possible to substitute the heavy hydrogen for the ordinary hydrogen in food substances and trace it through the body.

This work of Dr. Schoenheimer opened a new era in the study of the mechanism of living processes. Until the advent of heavy hydrogen it was not possible to study how the body utilized food. The heavy hydrogen serves as a tag for identification.

Since the discovery of heavy hydrogen, Dr. Urey, by the application of similar methods, has succeeded in concentrating heavy varieties of carbon, oxygen and nitrogen, which, with hydrogen, constitute "the big four" of life. Last year he concentrated the heavy variety of sulphur, an important constituent of several amino acids, building blocks of proteins.

With these five elements, Dr. Rittenberg stated, one can label not only every biologically important compound but even small parts of the molecule, so that when the chemist-in-the-body breaks up a

molecule the progress of its components can be traced.

Starting with the heavy isotope of hydrogen, Dr. Rittenberg, in collaboration with Dr. Schoenheimer, investigated the intermediary metabolism (utilization) of lipids, substances including fats.

These studies led to the general problem of how the living body breaks down and builds up proteins (protein metabolism), with the heavy isotopes of hydrogen and nitrogen (both constituents of proteins). The rapid interconversion and regeneration of proteins and their constituent amino acids have been studied, Dr. Rittenberg said.

Analytic Procedure Devised

As an offshoot of this work, he added, a new analytical procedure, known as "the isotope dilution method," was developed and applied to the analysis of proteins and fats. This new method of analyzing proteins, it was stated, opens the way for more accurate determinations of the structure of proteins, the most complex substances in nature, out of which she creates her living organisms.

Change Constant in Living Cell

The results of these studies so far indicate, Dr. Rittenberg stated, that "most, if not all, constituents of the living cell are in state of flux. The old elements are degraded, while new ones, identical in all respects, are re-synthesized from fragments of the older elements."

Further studies on this continual process of re-synthesizing new identical elements out of the fragments

of the old may shed new light on the process of aging, he said. The living organism, Dr. Rittenberg explained, is a mechanism which can convert chemical potential energy into useful work. This system is different from all others in that the mechanism and the fuel have the same gross composition. This fundamentally is the reason why the study of intermediary metabolism is experimentally so difficult.—*New York Times*.

Overcoming Selfishness

Question: "How can I avoid being self-centered?"—C. D.

Answer: When you are one with the Infinite, you don't know that there is ego (self); you only know that the wave of life could not work and dance without the ocean back of it. If you become too much attached to the things of this life, you will forget God. That is why we lose things, not to punish us—but to see if we love these little things more than the Infinite.

In order to develop in any way, you must first follow the universal spirit of Christ. That doesn't mean that you would have to be crucified in order to be like Christ, but all useless desires have to be crucified. Some people seek the gifts of God, but those who are wise seek God, who is the Giver of all gifts. Jesus taught us to be in the world, but not of the world. You may try to please people and after a while they forget you. Sometime a statue may be erected in your honor, but few will look at it and remember your good deeds.

Sociability must be developed,

but that doesn't mean that you need to know everyone personally and individually. You must invite the whole world to your heart. Christ Consciousness encompasses everything in its love. That consciousness was born in the body of Jesus, in the body of Krishna, in the body of Buddha. Until you have attained that consciousness, you cannot judge others.

You must be ready at all times to spread the light of friendly service over all creatures whom you happen to contact. This requires constant mental effort and preparedness; in other words, unselfishness. The sun shines equally on diamond and charcoal, but one has developed qualities which enable it to reflect the sunlight brilliantly, while the other absorbs all the sunlight. You must emulate the diamond in your dealings with people. Brightly reflect the light of God's love.

The Call of Friendship

God lives and breathes in all. We are Americans or other nationality for just a few years, but we are God's children forever. The soul cannot be confined within man-

made boundaries. Its nationality is Spirit; its country is Omnipresence.

To have friends, you must manifest friendliness. If you open the door to the magnetic power of friendship, a soul or souls of like vibrations will be attracted to you. The more friendly you become toward all, the greater will be the number of your real friends. Friendship is a manifestation of God's love for you, expressed through your friends.

First, you will have to love your family as you love yourself. The greatest impulse is to love oneself only, but as soon as you can love someone else more than yourself, you have advanced. If you love yourself more than anyone else, you have closed yourself in. You are then surrounded by your ego (self). You must resurrect that ego, then you will love your family, neighbors, country and the whole world as you love yourself. If you wish to develop, you must go through three stages. True friendship consists in being mutually useful, in offering good cheer in distress, sympathy in sorrow, advice in trouble, and material help in times of real need. By being true to yourself and a true friend to others, you will gain the friendship of God. Once you make your love felt in the love for other people, it will expand until it becomes the One Love which flows through all hearts. If you fail to

be friendly, you are disregarding the divine law of self-expansion, by which alone your soul can grow into Spirit. Anyone who fails to inspire confidence in other hearts, who is unable to extend the kingdom of his love and friendliness into other soul territories, cannot hope to expand his consciousness into Cosmic Consciousness.

Reflect Divine Unity

Friendship is God's trumpet call, bidding the soul destroy the partitions which separate it from all other souls and from Him. True friendship unites two souls so completely that they reflect the unity of Spirit and its divine qualities. When divine friendship reigns supreme in the temple of your heart, your soul will merge with the vast Cosmic Soul, leaving far behind the confining bonds which separate it from all of God's animate and inanimate creation.

Our Highest Duty

Question: "What is my highest duty?"—*Y. I.*

Answer: Your highest duty is to God. His power is greater than the sunlight and all else put together. When death comes, your duty to the world will end immediately. That is what God wants to show you—that this world is only a playhouse wherein you were sent to play; but to forget your Heavenly Father will lead to misery.

God is the life behind the life, the sight behind your eyes, the taste behind your tongue, and the love behind your love. To realize

this to the fullest extent is Self-realization. Without God's power you can do nothing. If you always hold this thought, you cannot go wrong, because you will have purified the temple of your mind and soul with the vibrations of God.

The voice of the Infinite is strong and powerful, and when that power surcharges your body, all wrong vibrations vanish. When you feel that Eternal Power in every way is talking through your voice, through your silence, through demonstration, through your reason, then you know that you have something that will last beyond the grave.

You are not the Body

You think that you are the body, but you are not. Your consciousness is centered in the body, but when you are asleep, your consciousness is beyond this. Your love is mostly concentrated on your little body, but that love must be expanded to the kingdom of the Infinite. Since we are all limited, we must reclaim our kingdom by expanding our love. Think what a beautiful world this would be if all of us loved others as we love ourselves. Meditation is a sure way to prove that you are not the body but a child of God. We are the waves of the ocean, the waves of life, and at death we merge in the Ocean of God and then come out again as a wave in the next life.

Do not excuse yourself by saying that you are too busy to think of God. You must give up some of your useless pursuits and idle thoughts to make time for Him.

The world takes out of you all it can, and keeps you engaged with many worthless habits and unproductive activities. Day after day you wish to be different and make new resolutions, but you are being carried a prisoner, bound hand and foot by the cord of your habits woven by you through your environment. To eat, work, and die is not enough; the animal does the same.

Use your precious gift of reason and try to find God. You need not go into the forest where other, although different, temptations will assail you and perhaps conquer you. Your duty is in the world where your karma (action) has placed you to work out your salvation by serving your fellow-men. You can find God in the solitude of your own room when, in the early morning hours and at night before sleeping, you compose yourself for meditation and thought on the great divine principle that created you.

Be Determined to Know God

Mortal law is governed by the law of cause and effect, but you cannot get what you visualize until you know God. When you know Him, then the law of cause and effect is removed and you acclaim your divine birthright. Good actions without reference to God may bring good results according to the law of cause and effect applied to human actions, but they cannot produce the knowledge of God. If the sun tries to shine through a crystal, and you put your hand in front of the crystal, the sunshine

cannot penetrate it. So it is with God. His power is shining everywhere, but if you put forth your hand of restlessness, God's light cannot shine through clearly.

God will not reveal Himself to you unless your thoughts for Him in meditation and at other times are strong enough to blot out all unimportant distracting thoughts. You must determine today to know God and act on your desire by making every effort now to cultivate His friendship. It is not necessary to neglect your worldly duties. Perform them with the thought that you are realizing Him through them and that thus you are pleasing Him.

Only when we unite our souls with God shall we get back the birthright which we have lost. We only get prosperity and happiness according to the measure of our past actions and determination. Don't live as a slave, but as a king. The wave becomes the ocean and the ocean again becomes the wave. So, we become God and God becomes us. He is all there is in the universe that can keep us entertained evermore. All things else will tire us, except God alone!




