

SRF Museum Exhibit

On April 29th an exhibition of unique stones, fossils and other articles of historical and artistic interest from Paramhansa Yogananda's large collection was given at the San Dieguito High School, Encinitas, under the auspices of *Self-Realization Fellowship*. Paramhansaji and a large group of disciples spent 14 hours a day preparing, classifying and arranging the display, which was enthusiastically received by all who came. The exhibit included such diverse objects as carved ivories and human heads shrunken by the Jibarro Indians of Western Ecuador, dinosaur tracks and armor and carved jade, the skin of a boa constrictor and bamboo trays ornamented with Burmese gold, and a phantom quartz crystal with included water and bubbles, which is millions of years old.

The accompanying pictures give some idea of the display. Paramhansa Yogananda is standing with Mr. Tom W. Preece, District Super-

intendent, and Mr. Harold Grande, a teacher at San Dieguito High School.

Paramhansaji hopes to be able to establish a museum in which to house this collection, only part of which could be shown at the High School. We are happy to have the following letter from the District Superintendent and the Faculty Club Secretary of the School:

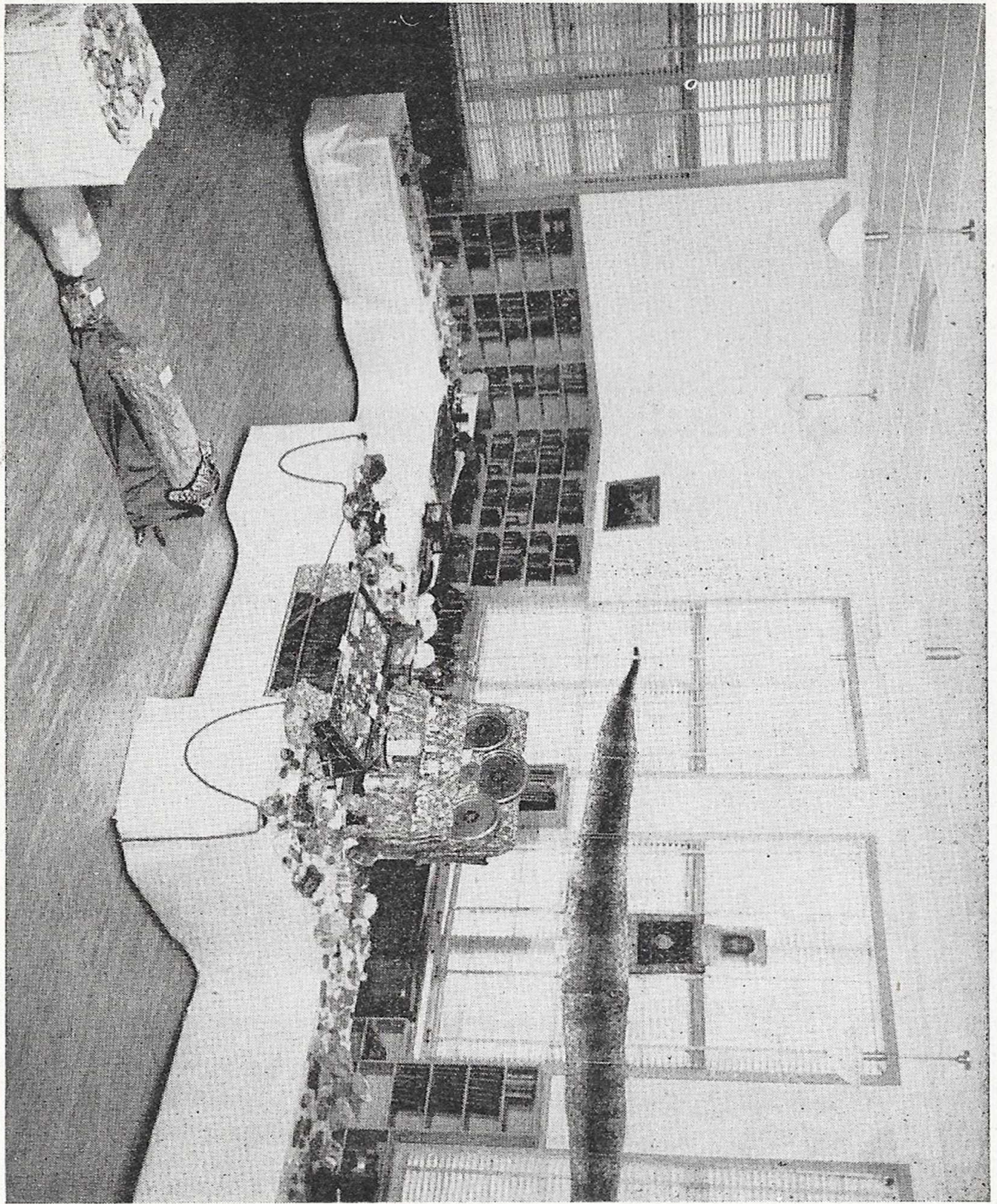

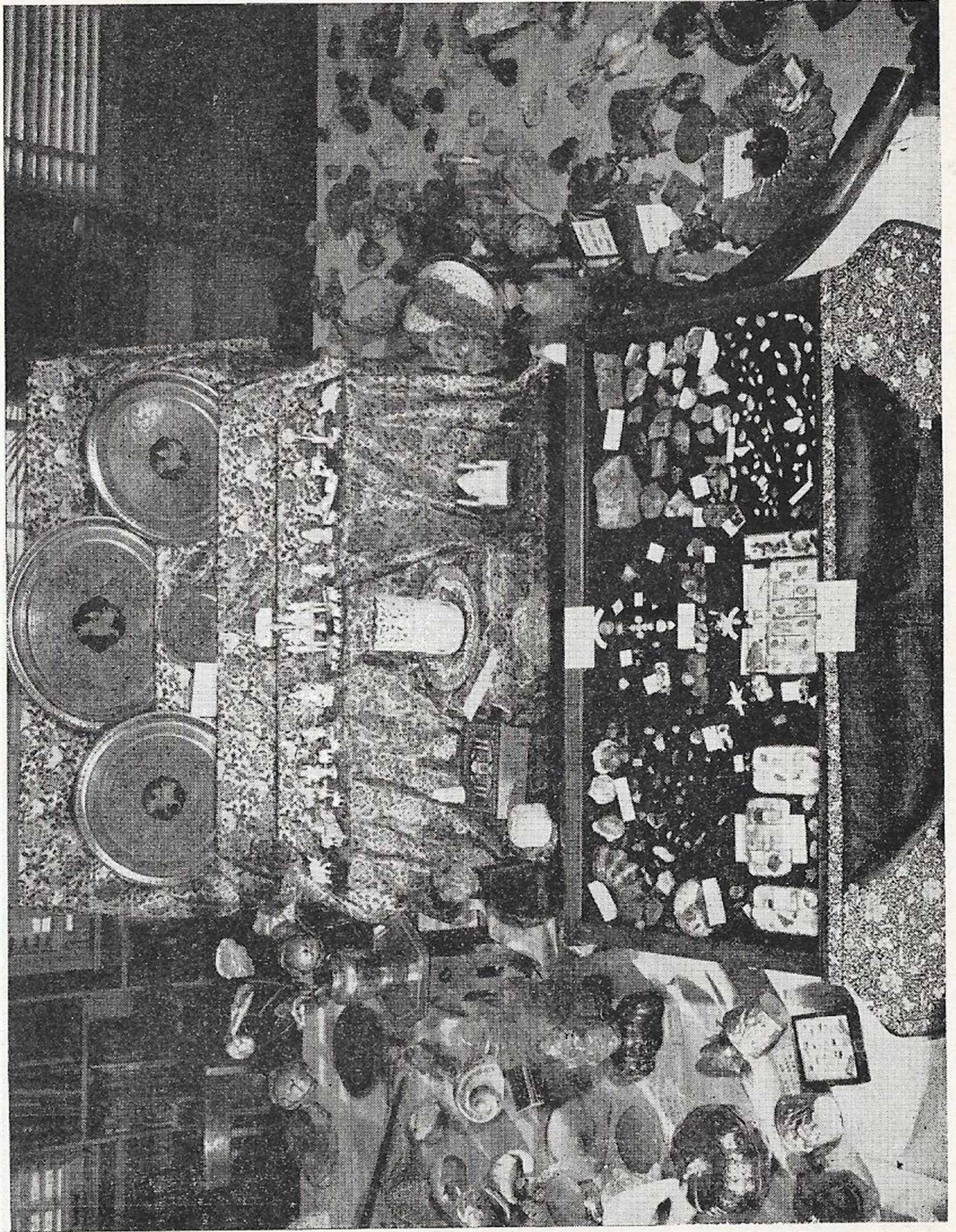

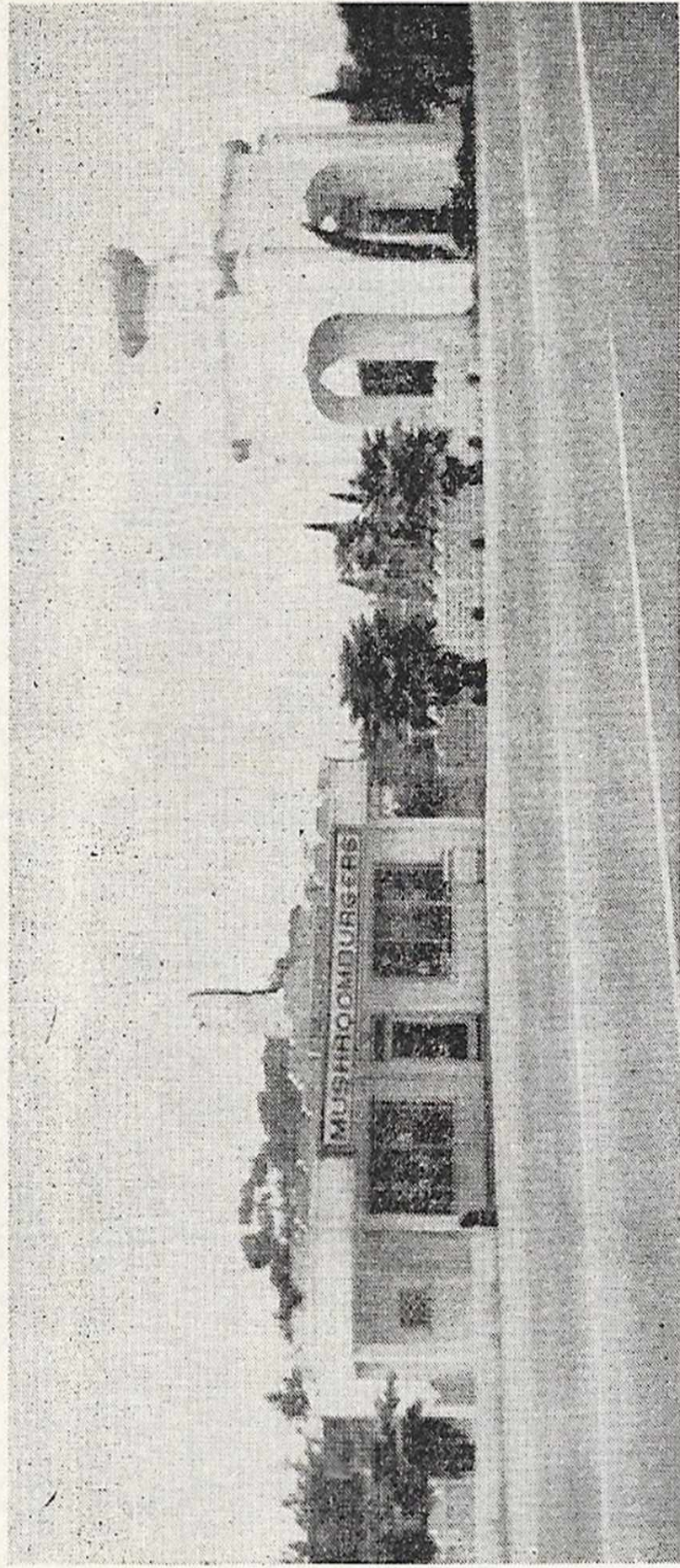
